

Jaws Race (Pursuit)

NOTICE OF RACE

Saturday March 24, 2018; First Warning at 1200 hours
Start and Finish off the Club Deck
Organizing Authority is the Sausalito Yacht Club

The Sausalito Yacht Club (SYC) invites Bay Sailors to come out for the annual "Jaws race." The race consists of a single pursuit race with the start and finish off the deck of the Sausalito Yacht Club. A pursuit race has a staggered start with the slower boats starting first and the faster boats starting later. The start times are based on PHRF handicaps. Time on Distance corrections shall be used. The first boat to finish wins, the second to finish is second, and so on.

The intent is to have about a two hour race around the bay. Senior member Bud Livingstone (now deceased) created this race to bring back the old club tradition of starts and finishes off the club deck. The "Jaws" perpetual trophy was also donated by Bud.

Entry to the race is open to all sailboats with a current PHRF handicapping certificate. A copy of your PHRF certificate must be received by the race committee or listed on the current YRA web site (www.yra.org) to complete your registration. Yachts without a current certificate or YRA listing may have a PHRF number assigned at the discretion of the race committee.

RULES: The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) shall govern this Series, designated Advertising Category A.

There will be two PHRF divisions for scoring purposes, Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker.

The warning signal will be sounded at 1200.

Trophies will be awarded after the race. The perpetual trophy will be presented to the winners of each division.

The Entry fee is waived for SYC club members and is \$30 for non-members. All entries must be received, at the club or online, by 1200 hours on Thursday March 22nd.

Sailing Instructions with competitor start times will be posted on the club website and available at the club no later than Thursday March 22nd at 2000 hours. Results will be available after the race at the club and posted on the club's race bulletin board and web site as soon as practical.

Some hosted hors d'oeuvres and beverage will be provided for participants after the race until they run out. The Jaws Race is part of the SYC On-the-water Showcase for the day. There will be concurrent sailing for youth and adults, a "Let's Go Boating" cruise, a Membership Open House, a pirate or clown for children, a band, and a BBQ.
