

# Del Rey Yacht Club 2018 William Berger Series William Stein Series Notice of Race

Del Rey Yacht Club invites PHRF (crewed, single/double handed) and ORCA boats to participate in the 45<sup>h</sup> annual William Berger Series. Cruising Class boats are invited to participate in the William Stein Series.

# 1 RULES

- 1.1 This Regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- **1.2** The PHRF of So California Rule #8 (Marine Industry Racer) does not apply. Individuals that satisfy the definition of "Marine Industry Racer" may not helm a boat in the Cruising Division.

## 2 ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY and CLASSES

- 2.1 Divisions may be established for PHRF (crewed, single/double handed), ORCA, Cruising and Novice Cruising Classes. Boats and skippers deemed not suitable for entry into the Stein Series may be moved into the Berger Series at the discretion of the RC.
- 2.2 PHRF entries must be current members of PHRF of So. California.
- **2.3** Eligible boats may enter by submitting a separate entry form for each race online at DRYC.org no later than 1800 the day before each race. Late entries may be accepted. Paper entries will not be accepted.
- **2.4** The Series class splits will be posted at DRYC.org no later than 1800 the day before Race 1. An exception may be made if a boat's rating is changed by its rating authority.

## 3 ENTRY FEES

The entry fee for races 1, 2, 3, and 5 is \$35.00 per race and must be paid online at time of entry. The entry fee for race 4 is \$45.00, and includes beverages and use of the BBQ grills at DRYC's Catalina Harbor facility. United States Sailing members may receive a \$5.00 discount at entry.

## 4 SCHEDULE

- **4.1** There will be a mandatory Skippers Meeting for all Cruising Division entries at 0900 January 6, in the bar at DRYC. There will be no additional Skippers Meetings
- **4.2** Races 1,2,3 and 4 will start in the vicinity of Marina del Rey H mark. Race 5 will start in the vicinity of the west end of Catalina Island.
- 4.3 The first warning for all races will be at 1155.

## 6 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted by 0900 each race day on a bulletin board inside the DRYC Clubhouse. The RC will attempt to post Notices at DRYC.org

## 7 SCORING

- 7.1 For series class scoring, the Low Point System (RRS A4) will apply.
- **7.1 (a)** A boat that started and DNF shall be scored 1 point more than the number of finishers in that class. This changes RRS A4.2
- **7.2** For Series overall scoring (Berger or Stein perpetual trophy), all boats will be scored as a single group using corrected time for each race. This changes RRS A9.
- 7.2 (a) All race scores will count. This changes RRS A9.
- **7.2 (b)** A boat that started and DNF shall be scored 1 point more than the number of finishers in that race. This changes RRS A9

### 8 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The RC will attempt to monitor and announce starting information and recalls on VHF 68.

### 9 RATINGS/HANDICAPS

- **9.1** PHRF entries will be scored using 2018 PHRF so Cal Area B RLC ratings for races 1-5.
- **9.1 (a)** Details on obtaining or renewing a rating <u>http://www.phrfsocal.org</u> (\$65.00 fee)
- **9.2** The Cruising Division will use 2018 PHRF So. Cal. Corinthian Ratings Area B RLC ratings for races 1-5, available at the PHRF website. <u>http://www.phrfsocal.org/</u>. All Cruising Division entries must sail in their rated configuration. Non spin adjustments will apply. Boats changing configuration, Spin, Non Spin will be scored as a new entrant.

- **9.3** For ORCA entries, their assigned Time Correction Factors (TCF) will apply.

Limited docking is available at DRYC by calling the DRYC Office at **310-823-4664**.

For race #4, DRYC moorings at Catalina Harbor may be reserved by calling **310-823-4664** no later than 1600 the Wednesday before race #4.

# 11 TROPHIES

- **11.1** All trophies will be presented at DRYC (See individual race Sis).
- 11.2 Individual Race and Series trophies will be presented to the first 3 boats in each class.
- **11.3** The PHRF Division series winner will have their name engraved on the William Berger Perpetual Trophy. Single/double handed class is not eligible for this trophy
- **11.4** The Cruising Division series winner will have their name engraved on the William Stein Perpetual Trophy.
- **11.5** The ORCA Multihull Division will have their name engraved on the ORCA Ocean Series Perpetual Trophy
