# SUPPLEMENT to the STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTION (Numbering corresponds to the RRS Appendix S)

[DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the protest committee.

#### 4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.1 The official notice board is located on the external west wall of the clubhouse. Notice is may also be published at <a href="http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/16056">http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/16056</a>.
- 4.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole located on the front lawn of the clubhouse.

#### 5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

5.1 A maximum of four (4) races may be sailed in any one day, at the discretion of the CRO.






#### 6. CLASS FLAG

The class flag will be the shark insignia on a contrasting background.

#### 7. THE COURSE



- 7.1 Only the course shown in this supplement will be used for the event and as such, no course designation will be posted; no later than the warning signal the race committee may display the approximate compass bearing and distance of the first leg.
- 7.3 Rounding order: Start 1 (port) 1a (port) 2s/2p (gate) 1 (port) 1a (port) Finish
- 7.4 If mark 1a is not present, it will be omitted from the rounding order.
- 7.5 If either of mark 2s/2p are missing, the remaining mark will be rounded to port.

#### 8. MARKS

- 8.1 Marks 1, 1a, 2p and 2s will be orange inflatables.
- 8.2 The starting mark will be a green inflatable.
- 8.3 The finish mark will be a red inflatable.
- 8.4 The new mark, as provided by 10.1, will be a yellow inflatable. In the event of a change of the next leg of the course, mark 1a will not be relocated. The new mark will be rounded to port.













#### 12. TIME LIMITS

- 12.1 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A4 and A5.
- 12.2 Mark 1 Time Limit 45 minutes
- 12.3 Race Time Limit 2 hours
- 12.4 Finishing Window 30 minutes
- 12.5 The target time is 60 minutes for the first boat to sail the course and finish. Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This change RRS 62.1(a).

### 13. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 13.1 The jury desk is located under the tent on the patio.
- 13.6 Appendix T will apply.

## 14. REPLACEMENT OF CREW OR EQUIPMENT

- 14.1. Substitution of competitors will not be allowed without prior written approval of the race committee. [DP]
- 15.2 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless authorised by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the committee at the first reasonable opportunity. [DP]

#### 15. EQUIPMENT AND MEASUREMENT CHECKS

15.1. On the water, a boat can be instructed by a member of the race committee or the technical committee to proceed immediately to a designated area for inspection.

Ashore equipment may be inspected or measured.

#### 16. RADIO COMMUNICATION

16.1. The race committee may communicate information on VHF 72. Failure to make these communications or the sequence in which they are made shall not be grounds for redress. This change RRS 62.1(a).
