NOTICE OF RACE

Wellington Regatta
South Bay
Three Races Scheduled

MARCH 10, 2018

RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.2 Racing rules 44.1 and A2.1 will be changed as follows:

- RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- RRS A2.1. The first sentence of that paragraph is changed by deleting “excluding her worst score” and replacing it with “no score will be excluded.”

1.3 The Sailing Instructions will be published on the Racing Section of the Coronado Yacht Club website and the front counter the day of the race. Supplementary sailing instructions, if published, will be on the official notice board located on the front porch of Coronado Yacht Club no later than 1000 on the day of the race.

1.4 Scores from this Regatta are part of the Kempff Trophy for the Coronado Yacht Club.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats over 20’ in length. Members of the Coronado Yacht Club and any member in good standing of a yacht club recognized by US Sailing, SCYA or SDAYC are invited to race.

3.2 Skippers of eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration (available on the Racing portion of the Coronado Yacht Club website) by midnight, March 9, 2018.

3.3 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.

4 FEES

This regatta is free for Coronado Yacht Club members, and \$25 for non-members. Payment can be made online during registration.

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration: From now until March 9, 2018.

5.2 Date of racing: March 10, 2018. NOTE: This is a change to avoid a regatta conflict with the 29 Midwinter West Regatta on March 24th.

5.3 Number of races: Three races are planned. Less than three races may be sailed depending on conditions.

5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race will be 1200.

5.5 No warning signal will be made after 1530.

6 MEASUREMENT

6.1 Each boat shall possess or produce a valid PHRF or Coronado Yacht Club Class C rating. Boats that do not have a current CYC or PHRF handicap will need to determine a rating with the current CYC Handicap Representative.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS The sailing instructions will be available on the Racing Section of the Coronado Yacht Club website. On the day of the race, Sailing Instructions will also be available on the front counter of the CYC office.

8 VENUE

8.1 Attachment A shows the approximate location of the racing areas.

9 THE COURSES Windward – Leeward – Reaching race course. Course diagrams and numbering to be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 For all classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

12.2 RRS A2.1. The first sentence of that paragraph is changed by deleting “excluding her worst score” and replacing it with “no score will be excluded.”

12.3 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in RRS 70.5. Appendix K

12.4 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. Race Committee will monitor a VHF channel, available the day of the race.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for

material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 INSURANCE Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.
