Notice of Race

Blackbeard Sailing Club (BSC), Organizing Authority of the 2018 SoundBank ETYSA Regatta cordially invites all monohull sailboats with a valid NCPHRF Rating Certificate to join us for racing on the Neuse River near Upper Broad Creek. The SoundBank ETYSA Regatta will be held April 21 and 22 at Blackbeard Sailing Club, 1215 Barkentine Drive, New Bern, NC 28560

1. The race will be governed by the *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. The *Sailing Instructions* will be available at the <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/16246</u> at least one week prior to the event. Please print the instructions and bring them with you to the regatta. A limited number of copies will be available at the skippers meeting.

3. This race is open to one-design classes, and monohull boats with a valid NCPHRF rating certificate

4. Classes are expected to be Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker and cruising. Each class can be further divided into divisions based on rating ranges and number of entries at the discretion of the PRO

5. The scoring will be in accordance with Appendix A, PHRF finishes will be calculated time on time.

6. The courses will be around buoys and government marks, including windward, leeward or reaching marks and will be displayed on the starboard side of the signal boat. Marks shown in red are to be left to port, those in green to starboard.

7. Penalties will be changed to include Appendix V change V1

8. The regatta schedule will be:

a. Skippers meeting at 9:00 Saturday, April 21

b. First start on Saturday is 11:00

C. First start on Sunday is 10:00

d. Social directly after racing at BSC on Saturday

e. Awards will be promptly at 2:00 on Sunday

10. There will be a limited number of free slips available at BSC. Please contact the Dock Master, Bill Dreschler, at 252-639-0316 to request a slip. Please include length, beam and draft with your request.

11. Race entry will be \$50. There is an early bird discount of \$10 for boats registering prior to April 10, 2018

12. Registration will be online at the <u>event website</u>. Late registration will be available at until 1900 on April 18. No registrations will be accepted after that time.

13. There will be a social at Blackbeard Sailing Club immediately after racing on Saturday, April 21. The club will serve burgers, brats, potato salad, beans, chips and a limited amount of adult beverages. You can order and pay for your meal tickets with your boats entry online or you can contact Irene Vuich at <u>dufovuich@suddenlink.net</u> to reserve a meal and pay on the day of the event. Meals reserved in advance are \$10 and meals without a reservation are \$12.
