

**2018 TYCC Spring Regatta**  
**April 7, 2018**  
**Hosted by Tampa Yacht and Country Club**  
**NOTICE OF RACE**

**(This Notice of Race may be amended from time to time pursuant to rule 89.2.)**

The regatta will be organized by Tampa Yacht and Country Club.

**1. Rules**

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

**2. Eligibility**

2.1. The Flying Scot fleet is open to all boats of the Flying Scot class.

2.2. The Small Boat Handicap Fleet is open to all boats with a North American Portsmouth Yardstick Handicap.

2.3. The Fun Fleet is open to any sailing vessel over 20 feet in length. No PHRF certificate is required.

**3. Registration; Entry Fees**

3.1. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online form and paying the \$50 entry fee at [www.regattatech.com](http://www.regattatech.com). Competitors shall have completed **all** parts of the online registration form together with all fees paid, by March 16, 2018. Additional late entry fees of US \$15 shall be paid for late registrations completed online at least 24 hours prior to the competitors meeting. There is no on-site registration.

**4. Schedule**

4.1. Friday, April 6:

1930 Competitors Meeting/Check-in

4.2. The dry lot will be available to place and rig trailerable boats after 1600 on Friday using a small davit. You may also rig and launch your boat at the boat ramp located at Ballast Park and park in the dry lot. Wet slips are available; contact dockmaster to reserve.

4.3. Saturday, April 7:

1000 Warning Signal for first Flying Scot fleet race

1015 Warning Signal for Small Boat Handicap Fleet

1030 Warning Signal for Fun Fleet

Dinner and Awards after Racing

4.4. Number of races:

Class	Number of Races
Flying Scot	3

Small Boat Handicap Fleet 3

Fun Fleet 1

4.5. There will be no Warning Signal for the Flying Scot and Small Boat Handicap Fleet after 1500.

4.6. The TYCC bar and kitchen will be open on a cash basis.

## **5. Sailing Instructions**

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and may be available online.

## **6. Courses**

The courses will be included in the Sailing Instructions. All fleets will sail a drop-mark course with the exception of the Fun Fleet. The Fun Fleet will race around fixed marks.

## **7. Scoring**

7.1. The Low Point Scoring System in Appendix A will apply to the Flying Scot fleet and Small Boat Handicap Fleet, and one completed race shall constitute the regatta.

7.2. A boat's regatta score will be the total of all of her race scores in the Flying Scot fleet and Small Boat Handicap Fleet.

7.3. Any onedesign boats with 5 or more of the same class will be scored as their own fleet.

7.4. The Fun Fleet will be scored as announced at the Competitors meeting.

## **8. Disclaimer of Liability**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority, Tampa Yacht and Country Club, Race Committee, Protests Committee, volunteers, or any other affiliated persons ("Organizers") will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release and hold harmless the Organizers from any and all liability, associated with competitors' participation in this event. A waiver shall be signed by all competitors and/or their parent/guardian.
