NOTICE OF RACE

D.J.JOHNSON AROUND OAHU REGATTA

May 26th, 27th & 28th, 2018

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, pertinent Class/Fleet Rules, the Waikiki Yacht Club Standing Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Racing rules will be changed as follows:
 - 1.2.1. Rule 52 is changed to allow the use of powered winches
 - 1.2.2. Racing rule 49 does not apply to Multihulls.
 - 1.2.3.6.4 Redress: RRS 60, 63.2, 63.4 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60 (Participation Committee composition) are deleted.
 - 1.2.4. Rule 55 does not apply for spinnaker stopping materials only. It still applies to trash.
- 2. ADVERTISING: Advertising will not be restricted.
- 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY
 - 3.1. The regatta is open to all yachts with skippers who are members of HYRA member clubs and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authority. All yachts must meet the current ISAF cat 4 safety regulations. Eligible boats are required to register through regatta network. Please refer to:

- 4. CLASSES: Boats will be scored in PH X, A & B, Cruising & Multihull.
- **5. FEES:** The entry fees will be \$150.00 for US SAILING member.

- 10. SCORING: RRS Appendix A2 is modified to allow no throw-outs.
- **11. MOORING:** HYRA is contacting Ko Olina Marina to secure moorings for entrants. If we are not successful in securing mooring space from Ko Olina Marina, each entrant is responsible to secure mooring for the boat on the second day.
- 12. PRIZES: Prizes will be presented for PH X, A, B, Cruising & Multihull at the awards ceremony
