#### 1 RULES

# 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Optimist, Laser Radial, FJs and club 420 classes.
- The regatta is open to all Junior sailors. Competitors shall not have reached their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday by December 31, 2018.

<u>Charter Boats</u> NYCC owns Optimists and FJs and they may be available for charter. Charter fee \$50 with sails provided, \$35 without sails. Reserve in advance with the Waterfront Director.

**Support Boat Launching** Boats will be ramp launched from NYCC ramps, preferably the one near Hampton Blvd (the other 2 ramps will be used for the sailboats). Trailers will be stored at the Second Presbyterian Church (7305 Hampton Blvd. Norfolk, VA 23505), in the back of the Church.

Opti's will be parked on the grass. Lasers and c420s will be in the dry storage parking.

If you need fuel, please register at the Main Office Desk.
