

Sunset Series 2018

NOTICE OF RACE

Spring Series: May 8th – May 22nd – June 5th – June 19th

Summer Series: July 24th - August 7th - August 21st - September 4th

The Sausalito Yacht Club invites Bay Sailors to come out for the Sunset Series. Races are held on alternate Tuesday evenings in two four-race Series, designated Spring and Summer. Racing will take place in the Knox / Yellow Bluff area using courses optimized for conditions.

The first warning signal for each race will be sounded at 1830.

The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) shall govern this Series, designated Advertising Category A.

The low point scoring system RRS A4 shall be used. Each series shall be scored as a Series Longer than a Regatta per RRS A9. A minimum of one race shall be completed to constitute a series. For each series, if four races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. Otherwise, her score will be the total of her scores for the series.

Entry is open to all yachts with a current PHRF certificate and members of one-design fleets. Five or more one-design entries may constitute a class. Yachts without a PHRF Certificate may be assigned a rating at the discretion of the Race Committee.

Competitors may request a mail-in entry form at race@sausalitoyachtclub.org, or at the club. The Entry fee for an individual series is \$75; for both Spring and Summer, \$130. Individual races are \$30. Entries for the Spring Series submitted after May 1st will be subject to an additional \$15 late entry fee. Entries for the Summer Series submitted after July 17st will be subject to an additional \$15 late entry fee.

Trophies will be awarded to winners of individual races after each race. Series trophies will be awarded to series entries after the last race of each series. Single race entries are not eligible for Series trophies. At the conclusion of the Summer Series a perpetual trophy, The Lischeske Trophy, will be awarded. This goes jointly to the lowest scoring spinnaker and non-spinnaker competitors, from any class, across the two series.

Sailing Instructions will be posted on the club website and available at the club no later than 1800 Monday May 7th.

Results will be posted to the club's race notice board after each race and on the club website the evening following the race. For information,
