

Notice of Race Halloween Regatta – Monster Mash Saturday, October 20, 2018



Rules: This race shall be governed by the "rules" as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

Eligibility and Entry: Yacht Club membership is **NOT** required. The race is open to OD, PHRF, Cruiser, Dinghy and ORCA for the outside course.

Entry Fee: \$5.00. For all Juniors and College sailors there is **no entry** fee. Entries are available at dryc.org, regattanetwork.com or at DRYC.

Notice to Competitors: Any changes to this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the bulletin board on the South hallway inside the main entrance of the DRYC clubhouse. Notices available before race day may also be posted on the DRYC website (www.dryc.org).

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be made available on-line on the DRYC website, Regatta Network, and at the club at least two days prior to the race.

Classes: Final classes and start times will be posted by 0900 Saturday, October 20 on the official notice board at DRYC and on Regatta Network

Handicaps: For PHRF classes, Buoy Ratings for Area B1 will be used. For ORCA classes, ORCA ratings will be used. For Cruising classes, PHRF So Cal Corinthian or will be assigned by the DRYC race chair. Dinghy Portsmouth ratings will be used.

Starting Time and Location: This will be a single race. The Warning Signal for the first class to start is scheduled for **1355.** The starting line will be set in the vicinity of the "S" Mark, which is a yellow spar, approximately 1 1/2 NM at a heading of 235° from the middle of the Marina del Rey detached breakwater.

Courses: Outside the MDR detached breakwater, all classes including dinghies (a support boat will be in the racing area). Course will consist of a number of marks which Boats shall round in any sequence and in either direction continuing inside the MDR detached breakwater and finishing in front of Del Rey Yacht Club. This will be an inverted start. Keel boat course distance approximately 8.75NM. Dinghies 6.75 nm

Additional Equipment: PFD's (Type III or better performance when inflated) must be worn on all boats that do not have lifelines except for brief moments while changing clothing

Scoring: Low-Point Scoring system.

Trophies: Trophies for this race will be awarded at DRYC after the race. There will be 3 trophies per class.

Halloween Party/Raffle and BBQ Info: There will be a post-race BBQ (\$10.00 per person), Beer/Wine and a special "Monster Mash" drink. Water and sodas for the kids are free. In addition, for both adults (includes College racers), and Juniors races, there will be awards for the best costume at the party and the best boat crew with costumes while racing and not racing.
