

HYC ANNUAL REGATTA

June 30 – July 1, 2018 Hampton Yacht Club Hampton, Virginia

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020.
- 1.2 US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4 will not apply.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix V1 (Penalty at the Time of an Incident) will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to One-Design classes under 25'. Invited fleets include Viper 640s, 505s, HODs, Lightnings, J-24s, Sonars etc.
- 2.2 Entrants will be divided into 3 fleets; HODs, Sonar's and Open Fleet.
- 2.2 Boats may enter on Regatta Network by clicking

Or, they may submit a CBYRA Standard Entry Form and check at Registration.

- 2.3 The Entry Fee is \$45 if paid by Friday June 22. Entries received after that are \$55.
- 2.4 Free launch, haul, and boat/trailer storage is provided with multiple hoists available.

3. SCHEDULE

3.1 The regatta will consist of multiple windward/leeward races for all fleets on Saturday. On Sunday HODs and Sonars will sail multiple windward/leeward races and the Open fleet will sail 1 long distance race.

3.2 Saturday, June 30:

0830 - Registration/Check-In Opens (HYC Lounge)

1000 - Skippers Meeting (HYC Flagpole)

1130 – Warning Signal

ASAP after racing is social with refreshments in the "Viper Pit"

3.3 **Sunday, July 1**:

1000 – Warning Signal

ASAP after racing = Awards Ceremony and Social

** No starting sequence may begin after 1400 Sunday.

4. COURSES

- 4.1 Multiple windward/leeward races will be attempted each day for HODs and Sonars.
- 4.2 Multiple windward/leeward races will be attempted on Saturday and 1 long distance race on Sunday for the Open fleet.

5. RACING AREA

5.1 Off Hampton Flats approximately 1 nm SW of mouth of Hampton River (near mooring buoy).

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 Printed S.I.s will be available at Registration and posted on the Notice Board.
- 6.2 Preliminary S.I.s will be posted electronically several days prior to the regatta.
- 6.3 Final fleets, class flags, and Order of Starts will be provided at the Skippers Meeting. Preliminary, unofficial information may be posted at HYC and/or electronically prior to that.

7. SCORING & AWARDS

- 7.1 RRS Appendix A Low Point Scoring will be used (one throw-out after a minimum of 6 races)
- 7.2 Portsmouth handicapping system will be utilized for the Open fleet.
- 7.2 Awards will be presented in each fleet of at least three boats paid by June 15 as well as the overall winner of the open fleet.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
