NOTICE OF RACE

The Sequim Bay Yacht Club invites all keel boats, multi-hulls, and small centerboard boats to the 2018 SBYC May Cup at the John Wayne Marina in Sequim, Washington

Rules: The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions or the Appendices to the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility: Open for registrants who are SBYC Members. Non-member registrants may also participate but will pay a higher entry fee.

Registration: Eligible participants may enter by completing a registration form with the required fee online at http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/16854 or presenting it in person to the race committee prior to the start of the first race. Online registration is strongly encouraged.

Cost: SBYC members \$25. Non-member race fees are \$35.

Classes: Open to all keel boats, multi-hulls, and small boats with PHRF ratings. If you do not have a PHRF rating one will be supplied for you.

Races: There will be a maximum of 5 races with two different starts. Boats with PHRF ratings at 165 or below will start with the <u>Fast Boats</u> and boats with ratings at 166 or above will start with the <u>Half Fast Boats</u>.

No races will be started after 3:30 pm. The goal of the race committee is to conduct up to 5 races.

Course: Courses will typically be windward / leeward and may include leeward gates, weather offsets, and gybe marks. The goal will be to get up to 5 races with a typical race duration of 35 to 60 minutes.

Scoring:

Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A, Low Point Scoring System. No score will be excluded.

Prizes: Trophies will be awarded to the top 2 boats in each class

Saturday Dinner: Dinner is included with the registration fee. Beverages are available at the bar for purchase. Dinner will include Burgers, condiments, and several sides. <u>Please note number of crew you will have for dinner on the registration form.</u> If you have dietary considerations, please contact Dale Dunning at <u>TheOasisSportsBar@Gmail.com</u> prior to Thursday May 10th.
