

NOTICE OF RACE JULY 4TH REGATTA LAKE NORMAN YACHT CLUB June 30-July 1, 2018

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 Edition (RRS).

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

Eligible boats may enter the regatta by registering online. The Regatta is open to boats of the classes that register in accordance with the Notice of Race, including juniors, centerboards and keelboats. Boats shall be broken into classes as determined by the race committee, based upon registration. One Design Classes shall consist of not less than three like boats, except a multi-class handicap fleet that may be formed at the discretion of the regatta committee. The number and makeup of the PHRF classes will be determined based upon registration. PHRF keelboats must have a current LNKC PHRF certificate number. If you do not have a LNKC PHRF certificate, please apply for one at www.lnkc.com.

3. REGISTRATION FEES

Registration and Payment must be received by June 25th to avoid late fees. Fees:

- \$55 for Keelboats and Centerboards. Late fee \$10 after 6/25
- \$25 for Juniors. Late fee \$10 after 6/25
- \$15 Saturday Adult Dinner; Limited dinners will be available at event.
- \$10 Saturday Child Dinner (Under 12); Limited dinners will be available at event.

All fees and meals should be ordered on-line if possible. Limited registration will be available at the event.

4. SCHEDULE

Racing will be Saturday and Sunday only. Races scheduled are two for the PHRF keelboats, unlimited for both the one-design classes (centerboard and keelboat) and Junior courses. No races will be started after 1300 hrs. on Sunday. One race will constitute a regatta.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board located at the Race Management Center. Copies will be available at registration. PHRF keelboats will race under LNKC Lakewide Sailing Instructions (LSI).

6. THE COURSES:

There will be three race areas: Keelboat course will include PHRF keelboats on the down the lake course. One Design keelboats sailing around the buoys along with the Centerboard boats will be on the around-the-buoys course. Junior course will include Optis, Sunfish, Lasers and 420s sailing around the buoys course. Around-the-Buoys courses to be sailed include Windward-Leeward or Olympic. Junior courses will include only Windward-Leeward. Down-the-Lake courses will be as described in the LNKC LSI. All course locations will be in the vicinity of Lake Norman Yacht Club with specific locations to be announced at the Competitors' Meeting. Final fleet and course assignments are at the discretion of the race committee.

7. SCORING

Scoring will be Low Point Scoring System Appendix A except that all races shall be scored (changes appendix A2). Keelboats will race under PHRF Time on Distance, Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker classes expected. PHRF classes may be further divided based on the entries received. A minimum of one race constitutes a Regatta for all fleets.

8. AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded based on number of boats registered by June 20, 2018:
