

NOTICE OF RACE 2018 MEIGS REGATTA

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), and *GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events* (available at www.gya.org).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the following classes: GYA Capdevielle, Open Viper 640, Thistle, Club 420, Flying Scot, Finn, Laser, any Class Legal One Design, and Open Portsmouth.
- 2.2 Classes with three (3) or more registered boats shall constitute a fleet.
- 2.3 All registration shall take place online at http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17075

3. FEES

- 3.1 Entry Fees: Capdevielle, None; Thistles, \$53 per boat; all Other entries, \$50 per boat.
- 3.2 Non-Capdevielle Entry Fees includes one (1) ticket for an evening meal.
- 3.3 Additional tickets are available at \$20.00 per person.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Number or races: five (5) races will be attempted for each fleet. Additional races may be attempted for Open fleets at the discretion of the course Principal Race Officer (PRO).
- 4.2 Events:

<u>Saturday, July 7</u>	0800 - 1000 1100 1255 1255 1700	Check-In & Final Registration Skippers Meeting First Warning – Capdevielle Course. First Warning – Open Course. Evening Meal
<u>Sunday, July 8</u>	0800 0955 1055 1055	Brunch (Available in the Club) First Warning – Thistle Fleet (no starts after 1230) First Warning – Capdevielle Course. First Warning – Open Course. No race will be attempted after 1400.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions and courses will be available at Check-In.

6. VENUE

The racing area will be located on the waters of the Choctawhatchee Bay.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 7.2 The Low Point System (RRS A4) shall be used. For Capdevielle, no scores shall be excluded.
- 7.3 For Open fleets, when five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes Rule A2.
- 7.4 Ties shall be resolved according to RRS A8.

8. PRIZES

- 8.1 Non-Capdevielle prizes will be awarded based on the number of registered entries.
- 8.2 The Awards Ceremony will take place as soon as possible after the last race of the regatta.

9. LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Fort Walton Yacht Club will not accept any responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
