Notice of Race

The event will be hosted by Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club (CBYC). Club and Event information are available at www.cbyc.org and <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17092>

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- 1.2 Viper 640 Class Rules shall apply.
- 1.3 The Organizing Authority (OA) is CBYC.
- 1.4 In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race (NOR) and the Sailing Instructions (SI), the SI shall prevail. **This changes RRS 63.7.**
- 1.5 The Viper 640 Class shall be responsible for administering any procedures or documents required by Class Rules.
- 1.6 **US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 60, 63.2 and 63.4 are NOT in effect.**
- 1.7 OA reserves the right to amend this NOR and to post updated NOR at Regatta Network

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Entry in this regatta is open to all boats that are in compliance and good standing with the Viper 640 Class.
- 2.2 Each boat must be entered by an individual who is a member of a yacht club or sailing association that is a Member of US Sailing (or National Authority).
- 2.3 Entries are on line with <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17092>. Entries will close at 10AM Saturday August 18

3. FEES

The entry fee is \$75.00 USD. After August 12, 2018 there will be a late fee of \$10 for a total of \$85 USD.

4. SCHEDULE

Saturday, August 18

1000hrs: Skipper's Meeting in the Dry Storage Yard
1225hrs: Warning Signal Race 1
ASAP Warning Signal Races 2, 3 & 4
Post Race Appetizers at the CBYC Clubhouse

Sunday, August 19

1225hrs: Warning Signal Race 5
ASAP Warning Signal Race 6 & 7
1730hrs: Post Race Reception, appetizers and awards at CBYC Clubhouse.

No Race Shall Be Started after 1530 Hours on August 19th

The Race Committee (RC) at its discretion may run fewer races on Saturday or more races on Sunday or less than the seven (7) scheduled races based on wind and weather conditions.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at CBYC and on line at regatta network.

6. RACING AREA

The racing area will be behind the Middle breakwater or in the Pacific Ocean, approximately (3/4) mile at 220 degrees from Angels Gate.

7. COURSES

Courses shall be windward/leeward with leeward gates per the SI.

8. SCORING

8.1 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply except no score will be excluded. **This changes Rule A2.**

8.2 Seven (7) races are scheduled. Three (3) races must be completed to constitute a regatta

9. PENALTY SYTEM

The penalty system described in 44.1 and 44.2 shall apply.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

The RC shall communicate information on channel TBD and make every effort to broadcast course and OCS information to boats on the water.

11. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place boats.

12. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be permitted, subject to any provisions of individual Class Rules.

13. BERTHING
