NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Racing rule(s) will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to any USSCMC Member and their guests, in all boat types available for use at the USSCMC, except Optis and O'pen Bics.
- 2.2 The racing is intended for adults; however, students participating in High School sailing shall qualify as an adult. Any student who is under age 18 and is not part of the High School Sailing Program, may participate provided they are in a boat with a qualifying adult.

3 SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Registration can be completed by informing the Race Committee of your intent to Race.
- 3.2 Racing will occur June 5, 12,19, 26; July 10, 17, 24, 31. NOTE no racing on July 3.
- 3.3 The number of races per event will be determined by the race committee each afternoon as conditions allow.
- 3.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1800.
- 3.5 No warning after 1935

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available prior to June 5, electronically and at the USSCMC.

5 PENALTY SYSTEM

- Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 5.2 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

6 SCORING

- 6.1 All scoring will be based on one design.
- 6.2 Keeping track of total scores or series scores is up to the individual competitors.

One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. Two boats or more of any type will constitute a fleet

7 PRIZES

Prizes will be in the form of applause and praise from your competitors.

8 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
