NOTICE OF RACE

The Women on the Water / Woman at the Helm Regatta is co-hosted by the Association of Santa Monica Bay Yacht Clubs and the following member clubs: South Bay Yacht Racing Club, Pacific Mariners YC, Santa Monica Windjammers YC, California YC, Del Rey YC and the Women's Sailing Association of Santa Monica Bay. 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2 DRYC is the Organizing Authority in conjunction with the ASMBYC

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **2.1** The regatta is open to one-design keelboats, PHRF So Cal boats rated 222 or lower, and Cruising Class boats with PHRF So Cal Corinthian rating. Boats with ratings outside this range may petition the Event Chair for entry.
- **2.2** There will be three (3) divisions:
- a. Women on Water (WOW), female helmsperson and all female crew.
- b. Woman at Helm (WAH) Performance, female helmsperson with co-ed crew.
- c. Woman at Helm (WAH) Cruising, female helmsperson with co-ed crew.
- **2.3** WAH divisions with less than four (4) entries may be combined with another WAH division.
- **2.4** One Design fleets with four or more entries in one of the divisions above will be eligible for separate fleet trophies. One-design boats with fewer than four (4) entries may be assigned a rating and raced with boats of a similar type.
- **2.5** Boats racing in the standard PHRF Performance division, will race with their PHRF So Cal Buoy ratings.
- 2.6 Cruising division boats will enter using their RLC Corinthian Rating. Non-spinnaker offsets will apply.
- **2.7** Skippers must be women and members of a yacht club or sailing association affiliated with SCYA or US Sailing.
- **2.8** Women who are not a member of a yacht club or sailing association affiliated with SCYA or US Sailing may petition the organizing authority for waiver on 2.7.

- 2.10 Entry deadline Friday November 2nd at 7:00 pm. Late entries may be accepted by the Race Committee.
- 2.11 Boats without current ratings may be accepted with a rating assigned by the Race Committee

3. FEES

3.1 The entry fee is \$45.00, payable on line at the time of entry.

4.1 WOW and WAH: Five (5) races are scheduled; three (3) on Saturday and two (2) on Sunday. WOW/WAH Cruising: Three (3) races are scheduled; two (2) on Saturday and one (1) on Sunday.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS, CLASSES AND ORDER OF STARTS

6. VENUE

- **6.1** The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay outside the Marina del Rey breakwater.
- 6.2 WOW & WAH races will be sailed with the area shown on Marina del Rey Course Chart 17.
- **6.3** WOW/WAH Cruising races may go beyond the area shown on Marina del Rey Course Chart 17.

7. COURSES

- **7.1** Courses for WOW Performance and WAH Performance will be primarily windward / leeward but may include pursuit races.
- 7.2 Courses for the WOW/WAH Cruising will be random leg (RLC).

8. SCORING

- **8.1** Low-Point scoring system will be used.
- **8.2** No races will be excluded from the series scores. This changes rule A2.
- **8.3** One race must be completed to constitute a series for each division.

9. HOSPITALITY

Skippers meeting at 9:00 location Del Rey Yacht Club.

On Saturday, post-race hospitality will be held at Pacific Mariners YC, 13915 Panay Way, MDR CA.
On Sunday, post-race hospitality and awards ceremony will be held at Del Rey Yacht Club 13900 Palawan Way, MDR CA.

10. PRIZES

- 10.1 The Robert S. Wilson Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner of the WOW division.
- **10.2** The WSA Perpetual Trophy for Woman at the Helm will be awarded to the winner of the largest WAH class (Performance or Cruising), provided that skipper/crew have not won this award previously.
- **10.3** The Cheryl Rembert Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the Martin 242 with the best performance in the WOW division.
- **10.4** Individual take home trophies will be awarded in each division according to the number of entrants per division.
- **10.5** A trophy will be awarded to the club with the most entries.
