

Notice of Race 2018 Weta Nationals Nov. 2nd- 4th. 2018

& Adventure Sail Event

1. Organizing Authority

The organizing authority is the Sarasota Sailing Squadron.

2. Rules

- 2.1 This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 2.2 The North American Weta One Design Class Rules are applicable to this event. The class standard main sail is legal for this event, the square head mainsail is not.

3. Eligibility & Entry

The regatta is open to the Weta Class Sailboat, both Single handed and double handed divisions.

4. Registration & Fees

4.1 Online Registration is available at: http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17315.

- 4.2 Registration is \$105 per single handed boat and \$145 per double handed boat. 2 Day Adventure Sail \$25 for weekend (Regatta Participants not eligible for Adventure Sail).
- 4.3 Regatta Entry Fee single handed includes one shirt and one dinner.
- 4.4 Regatta Entry Fee double handed includes two shirts and two dinners.
- 4.5 Registrations and payment received before October 22, 2018 will receive a \$15 discount.
- 4.6 Online registration will close October 26, 2018.

1225 Warning signal for both single and double handed boats. Three races to be attempted.

Refreshments after racing

Saturday, Nov 3

1000 Check-In and registration for Adventure Sail 1055 Warning signal for all fleets. Three races to be attempted. Refreshments and Dinner after racing Class Meeting following Dinner

Sunday, Nov 4

1055 First Warning Signal for all Fleets. Two-three races to be attempted.

1400 No Warning Signal after this time. Awards to be presented as soon as possible after racing. Refreshments and snacks available for purchase.

7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available online.

8. Venue

Racing will be in Sarasota Bay.

9. Scoring

9.1 Three (3) races constitute a regatta.

9.2 When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.

10. Prizes

Awards will be given out according to the number of registrants in each class and overall.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. Docking

All coach and spectator boats must launch from the public boat ramp near Pelican Man sanctuary or the 10^{th} Street Boat Ramp.

13. Parking

Parking is available for trailers and cars outside the main entrance only. Vehicles parked blocking SSS members' boats, interfering with access to the boat ramps, or hoist will be towed.

14. Accommodations

Tent and RV camping **MUST** be prearranged with club management, call the SSS office at: 941-388-2355 to make a reservation. <u>Space is limited</u>.
