NOTICE OF RACE

The “TODOS SANTOS REGATTA” is organized by Club Náutico Baja A.C.

Date and location: Todos Santos bay, Ensenada B.C. Sunday, October 7th 2018

RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* ISAF (International Sailing Federation) 2017-2020

If encountering any vessel not part of the Race the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (COLREGSs) shall apply

Handicaps “P.H.R.F.”

REGISTRATION:

At the “Paella Party” Hotel San Nicolas October 6th.

Entry Fee

The Race Fee will be: \$ 35 USD per boat. Includes: 1 ticket for the race party. Extra tickets 25 dlls. per person, includes: dinner and beer.

Race party starts at 18:00.

COMMUNICATIONS:

All boats must monitor Channel 69 VHF during pre-start and during the race.

COURSE

Around Todos Santos Island.

The start and finish line will be set aprox. 0.8 nm south of the entrance breakwaters of Coral Marina, from there the first leg will be towards the north point of island Todos Santos (magnetic course 239⁰), then outside the Island to the south point, from there back to the finish line outside Coral Marina breakwater (magnetic course 044⁰)

The official distance will be 18.5 nautical miles

START:

The start will be at 11:00 hrs. Sunday 7th.

Starting sequence will be:

Attention: 5 minutes before the start, white flag up

Preparatory: 4 min. before the start “P” and “I” flag up

One minute: 1 minute before the start flag “P” down

Start: White flag down

DURATION:

The Race will be closed at 17:00 hrs. Sunday 7th.

Protests:

Time limit to present a protest will be 1 hour after the race committee has arrived ashore.

Boats Not Finishing

Any boat that retires from the race must give notice to the committee boat by VHF radio Ch 69

Disclaimer of Liability

Persons and boats participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

SAFETY

A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race, SIs or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility.

By entering the Race, the boat confirms that she is fit for those conditions and her crew is competent to sail, navigate and compete in the Race.

The skipper is responsible to ensure that his boat is equipped and seaworthy so as to be able to face extremes of weather; that there is a crew sufficient in number, experience and fitness to withstand such weather; and that the safety equipment is properly maintained, stowed and in date and that the crew knows how to use it.

The use of life jackets is mandatory

The awards ceremony will be at the place announce on Paella party.

Trophy (perpetual) for the best corrected time.

Trophy (perpetual) for the second corrected time.

Trophy (perpetual) for the first to finish boat.
