This is a 13 mile pursuit race; each boat will be assigned a start time in minutes after the slowest rated boat starts. The assigned start time is calculated by the Race Chair and is based on the boats Portsmouth Rating DPN and expected duration of the race.

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Rule 40 is modified to require all competitors to wear personal floatation at all times except for short periods while changing clothes.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND CLASSES

- 2.1 The race is open to all centerboards boats of 20 feet or less with a Portsmouth DPN of 110 or less, and catamarans of 20 feet or less with a Portsmouth DPN of 110 or less.
- 2.2 Boats need to conform to class rules, including minimum and maximum crew weights and number of crew.
- 2.3 At the discretion of the Race Committee (RC), other boats may be invited to race. These invited boats are not eligible to win the Outlook Trophy.

#### 3. ENTRY AND FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$30 for boats crewed by 2 or more, \$15 for single handed boats.
- 3.2 Entries must be made online through [www.regattanetwork.com](http://www.regattanetwork.com) by 0900, Sunday, August 19. Competitors under the age of eighteen must have their entry signed by their parents or guardian.

#### 4. CLASSES

- 4.1 Three or more one design boats will establish a one design class.
- 4.2 Classes are mono-hull centerboards (20 feet and under) and multi-hulls (20 feet and under).

#### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at [www.regattanetwork.com](http://www.regattanetwork.com) and [www.sccyc.org](http://www.sccyc.org) web sites no later than 2000 hours on Friday, August 17.

7. **SKIPPER MEETING**

Skippers Meeting will be held at SCCYC at 1000 the day of the race. Starting times will be assigned then and copies of the SI's will be available.

8. **VENUE / COURSE**

- 8.1 The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay, west of the Marina del Rey Breakwater.
- 8.2 Course will use both MDR Marks, described in [Course Chart 17](#), and orange or yellow inflatable marks.
- 8.3 The course will be approximately 13 miles.

9. **SERIES SCORING**

Boats will be scored in the order of finish.

10. **TROPHIES**

Trophies will be awarded at SCCYC following the race.

11. **DISCLAIMER**

Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
