Sailing Instructions 2018 Memorial Day Distance Race Lake Canyon Yacht Club September 4, 2018

- 1. RULES: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017 2020.
- 2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS: Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice window located on the left side of the LCYC clubhouse door.
- 3. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE: Signals made ashore will be displayed from the "Super Dock". If a postponement is signaled ashore, a signal will be made not less than thirty (30) minutes after flag AP is lowered.
- 4. SCHEDULE: The first start will be at 10:30 AM
- 5. STARTING LINE: The starting line will be between the fixed mark outside the breakwater and an orange flag on the end of the main walkway.
- 6. START: The start will be a pursuit race format. Each boat's starting time will be distributed at the Skippers Meeting.
- 7. COURSE: The course will be distributed at the Skippers Meeting.
- 8. FINISH LINE: The finish line will be between the fixed mark outside the breakwater and an orange flag on the end of the main walkway. All boats will take their finish time and report it to the PRO or a scorer designated by the PRO (see below).
- 9. TIME LIMIT: There is no deadline for finishing. Please report retirements to the PRO or an official scorer designated by the PRO.
- 10. COMMUNICATIONS: All competitors are requested, but not required, to monitor VHF Channel 68 for safety and race control communications. The PRO will identify the official scorer at the skippers' meeting, or will serve as the official scorer, and will identify how to communicate with the scorer.
