

2018 Doublehanded Series Notice of Race

Organizing Authority: Tahoe Yacht Club

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Rule 40 will be changed as follows: Competitors shall wear personal floatation devices, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits or dry suits are not personal floatation devices.
- 1.3 A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty as described in rule 44.2 when she may have broken a rule of part 2 while racing.

2 ADVERTISING

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 This series is open to doublehanded boats (two persons per boat).
- 3.2 This series is open to any keelboat with a minimum LOA of 18 feet.
- 3.3 Boats shall hold a current PHRF certificate from the Lake Tahoe PHRF Committee.
- 3.4 The TYC will be using Regatta Network this year. Eligible boats may enter online at any time: http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17572

4 SCHEDULE

Wednesdays September 5, 12, 19, 26 (8 races) Warning 1700 hours. Two races are scheduled each evening.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7 VENUE

- 7.1 The racing areas will be near Tahoe City between Dollar Point and Tahoe Tavern with the start off the US Coast Guard Station.
- 7.2 The courses will be around fixed and/or temporary buoys as described in the sailing instructions.
- 7.3 A gate (rabbit) starting system will be used. Details will be provided in the sailing instructions.

8 SCORING

All races will be scored using the Tahoe PHRF Handicap System with Time-on-Time scoring as described by US Sailing: http://www.ussailing.org/competition/offshore/phrf

TCF = A / (B + PHRF)

Where A = 650

Where B will be assigned each night by the race committee:

B = 480 for heavy air, 550 for average conditions, 600 for very light air

9 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded based on entries.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Tahoe Yacht Club and any other organizing authority for the regatta will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Participating boats shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. Boat owners are solely responsible to ensure that such coverage is current and adequate.
