NOTICE OF RACE

The organizing authority is Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club (SMWYC), 13589 Mindanao Way, Marina Del Rey, CA 90292. (310) 827-7692.

1. Rules:

- 1.1. The race will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) except as changed herein or by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. PHRF of Southern California (PHRF SoCal) "Marine Industry Racer Rule" will not apply.

2. Eligibility:

- 2.1. This race is open to PHRF, Cruisers (PHRF Corinthian) and One Design.
- 2.2. To be eligible for entry, each boat must:
 - (a) be entered by an individual who is a member of US Sailing or other organization affiliated to US Sailing or to SCYA (or their own National Authority); and
 - (b) have a valid PHRF SoCal Rating Certificate; or
 - (c) for Cruising Classes, have a 2018 PHRF SoCal Corinthian Rating.

3. Entry:

- 3.1. Eligible boats must enter the race online at Regatta Network:

- 3.2. Entries must be received by 1200 on Saturday, October 6, 2018.
- 3.3. The entry fee is \$35.00 or \$30.00 for US Sailing Members.

4. Classes:

- 4.1. Classes will be established for PHRF, Cruising spinnaker, Cruising non spinnaker and One Design entries..
- 4.2. A minimum of 3 paid entries will be required to establish a class. Entrants of a class that has not met the minimum may be assigned to another appropriate class.
- 4.3. Classes, class flags and the order of starts will be posted on the official notice board outside the main office at Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club, online at Regatta Network and www.smwyc.org no later than 1800 hours on Saturday, October 6.

5. Schedule:

The scheduled time of the 1st Warning Signal is 1225. For PHRF and One-Design classes three races are scheduled. For the Cruising classes one race is scheduled.

6. Sailing Instructions:

Sailing Instructions will be available at SMWYC, online at www.smwyc.org or posted on the Regatta Network event website page no later than 1800 hours on Friday, October 5, 2018 <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17642>.

7. The Courses:

Courses will be set using marks on Course Chart 17.

8. Scoring:

8.1 All race scores will count. This changes RRS A2.1

8.2 PHRF Classes will use So Cal PHRF Area B Ratings.

8.3 Scoring for PHRF classes will be calculated using the time on distance method.

8.4 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

9. Radio Communication:

While on the water, the RC may communicate with competing boats via VHF radio

10. Awards:

Awards will be given in each class. Trophies will be presented at SMWYC after racing.
