# **NOTICE OF RACE**

# 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

# 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Competitors and coaches shall enter by completing the on-line entry form on the event website <u>www.diyc.org</u> and paying the required fees. Entries must be received no later than 1500, Nov 23, 2018.
- 2.2 The organizing authority may refuse registrations and accept later registrations at their sole discretion.
- 2.3 Competitors under 18 years of age shall present a signed and completed parent (or guardian) consent and declaration form at check-in. The forms are available for download on the event website.
- 2.4 The regatta is open to any monohull centerboard boats. Anticipated Classes: Optimist (Green, White, Blue, Red), Laser, Laser Radial and Laser 4.7, C420. There will also be a Portsmouth Class on <u>Saturday</u> <u>only</u> open to boats such as Fireball, Mutineer, Windmill, Lightning, Flying Scot, and Sunfish. Five or more like boats will be given a separate start and scored as a fleet. Other boats will be started and scored using the Portsmouth rating system.

- 3.1 The entry fee includes a regatta t-shirt for skipper and all crew, bag lunch on the water both days, and Saturday dinner tickets for skipper and all crew.
- 3.2 Extra Saturday dinner tickets and breakfast (Saturday/Sunday)may be purchased at event.
- 3.3 LATE FEE Entries received after midnight November 19 will be charged an additional \$25, and are not guaranteed to receive t-shirts.
- 3.4 All fees must add 7% sales tax.

#### 7 SCORING

- 7.1 Many races are scheduled. One race for a class or fleet must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 7.2 When 5 of more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

### 8 SUPPORT BOATS AND PERSONNEL

- 8.1 All support boats shall be registered with the organizing authority and will be required to comply with event support boat requests.
- 8.2 Except when assisting the Optimist Green Fleet competitors, support boats with team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first fleet to start until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

#### 9 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each fleet. Participation awards will be given to all Optimist Green Fleet competitors.

#### 10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Neither the organizing authority nor race committee will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
