

2019 Commodores' Challenge Regatta

In honor of Staff Commodore James Lonergan San Diego, California Saturday, April 6th, 2019

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. Each entry shall be helmed by the current Commodore of the Club for which the yacht is competing, from the warning signal through the finish of each race, except for one five-minute break, if necessary.
- 1.3. Crew shall consist of sailors who are members of the Commodore's yacht club, with the exception of one boat representative if the yacht entered is not owned by a member of the club.
- 1.4. Each entry may not have more than one WORLD SAILING Group 3 sailor. See: www.sailing.org/classification/index.php.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Each Yacht Club may enter one qualifying yacht.
- 2.2. To be eligible, yachts must have a keel, motor, lifelines, and LOA >=24' as well as a PHRF San Diego or PHRF Southern California "Buoy" rating between +80 and +170.
- 2.3. Yachts with both PHRF Southern California and PHRF San Diego ratings shall be scored with their PHRF San Diego rating.
- 2.4. Entries shall be submitted on-line via the SWYC website (http://www.southwesternyc.org) no later than 1700 hours Thursday, April 4th, 2019.
- 2.5. There is no fee for entering this regatta.

3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 3.1. A skippers' meeting and social hour will be held Friday, April 5th, 2019 at 1830 at Southwestern Yacht Club.
- 3.2. The first warning signal will be Saturday, April 6th, 2019 at 1155. Subsequent races will follow.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1. Sailing Instructions will be available via the SWYC website no later than the skippers' meeting Friday, April 5th, 2019 at 1830.
- 4.2. Notices to competitors will be posted on the RC bulletin board adjacent to the SWYC office and on the regatta web site no later than 0900 hours on the day of the event.

5. THE COURSES

- 5.1. Race #1 and #2 will be Windward/Leeward and held in the Coronado Roads.
- 5.2. Race #3 will start in the Coronado Roads and finish in the Shelter Island Basin in front of Southwestern Yacht Club.

6. SCORING

- 6.1. All entries will be scored together.
- 6.2. Competitors shall be handicapped according to their "Buoy" ratings for Windward/Leeward races and their "RLC" rating for the race to Southwestern Yacht Club
- 6.3. The regatta will be scored with the Low-point Scoring System as provided in Appendix A. There will be no throw outs. This modifies RRS Appendix A2.1.
- 6.4. One race shall constitute a series.

7. AWARDS

- 7.1. The Staff Commodore James Lonergan Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the first place Club at the Southwestern Yacht Club Opening Day ceremony.
- 7.2. All competitors are invited to enjoy the hospitality of Southwestern Yacht Club at the end of the day's racing.
- 7.3. Additional take home trophies will be awarded at the post race social.

8. DOCKAGE

- 8.1. Dock space is available for visiting yachts prior to the regatta. Please contact Carolyn Sherman, cmaidn@yahoo.com, 619-980-7245 for details.
- 8.2. All entries are encouraged to dock at the Southwestern Yacht Club guest dock Saturday, April 6th, 2018, after the races through the social hour.
