

NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This series is open to any boat holding a valid Monterey Bay PHRF certificate, and any One Design Fleet with three or more entries.
- 2.2 There will be the following divisions:

A Fleet PHRF 80 or Less

B Fleet PHRF 81 or Greater

Double Handed

lib and Main 181 or Less

Iib and Main Greater than 181

One Design Dinghy or Multi-Hull Fleets with three or more entries

- 2.3 Division assignments may be adjusted before the start of the regatta. If there are insufficient Jib and Main entries to warrant a separate division they will be incorporated into the PHRF Fleet with an appropriate handicap adjustment to be determined by the Race Committee.
- 2.4 Double-handed division shall have exactly two persons on board.
- 2.5 PHRF divisions shall have a minimum of two persons on board.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The regular entry fee is \$105.
- 3.2 Late entry fee: \$135.
- 3.3 Single day race fee: \$40.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 Registration is open until 1800 November 14, 2018. After 1800 on November 14, 2018 a late entry fee will be charged.
- 4.2 Registration can only be made on-line at the event web site listed at http://scyc.org/racing
- 4.3 A competitors' meeting will be held at 1000 hours on November 17, 2018 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.4 Races are scheduled on November 17, December 15, 2018 and January 19, February 16, and March 16, 2019.
- 4.5 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1155 hours each race day.
- 4.6 Three races are scheduled each race day.

Sailing Instructions


5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors' meeting and may be posted earlier on-line.

6 Venue

Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys between Capitola and Natural Bridges in an area approximately three miles from the Walton Lighthouse on the Santa Cruz Harbor west jetty. A course diagram will be provided in the sailing instructions.

7 Prizes

- 7.1 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse for daily prizes each race day after racing.
- 7.2 A final series awards ceremony will be held at the SCYC clubhouse following racing on March 16th.
- 7.3 Boats entered in divisions with three (3) or more entries in the regatta are eligible for prizes. Additional prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority based on participation.
- 7.4 Series Division winning boats with valid PHRF Ratings are eligible for entry in the Champion of Champions Regatta.
