NOTICE OF RACE

Turkey Day Regatta
Saturday November 17, 2018

Invitation / Organizing Authority:

You are cordially invited to participate in the BYC Turkey Day Regatta on November 17, 2018. This regatta is open to all eligible boats who file the proper entry form and fee.

The organizing authority for this Regatta is the Bay Yacht Club.

Rules:

This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the US Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS) including US Sailing Prescriptions, this Notice and the regatta Sailing Instructions. In the event of conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instruction shall govern.

Eligibility:

The regatta is open to any mono-hull boat that holds a current PHRF certificate or provisional rating from South Texas PHRF or has applied to the Principal Race Officer (PRO) for a temporary rating.

The PRO may assign a temporary rating to any boat for the purpose of this regatta and such decision on a boat's rating is final unless South Texas PHRF subsequently issues said boat a PHRF certificate. In the event, the South Texas PHRF rating will apply for races subsequent to the date of certificate issue.

Classes:

PHRF All Sails and 150 (non-spinnaker) classes.

For the formation of a class, two (2) boats will be required. Classes may be combined or eliminated at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer depending on participation.

Entry Fee: \$30.00.

Regatta Schedule, Saturday, November 17, 2018:

0900 hours:

Skippers meeting.

M/V *Bay Star* is on the hard for maintenance at Mile 533 Shipyard and is not anticipated to return to her berth at Lawrence Street T-Head in time for this regatta. **The skippers meeting will be held on the upstairs deck of the Corpus Christi Yacht Club.**

Sailing Instructions will be posted on-line through Regatta Network in advance of the meeting and also available at the meeting.

1030 hours:

First signal for races.

Races will start and finish at a race committee signal boat anchored outside the Corpus Christi Marina breakwater. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1030 hours. Signals for each succeeding race will be as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

Time and weather permitting, three races for each class. Windward-leeward courses for All Sails and triangular courses for 150 (non-spinnaker) class.

TBD: Awards ceremony on CCYC pool deck after races are concluded.

Prizes:

Trophies will be awarded for the top three finishers in each class.
