NOTICE OF RACE

This is a one-day regatta with buoy races for spinnaker boats and a distance race for others. All spinnaker boats 30' and under on the buoy course will compete for the perpetual Frank Selph memorial trophy. Frank was an avid MORC supporter and trophy is awarded in his honor.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 44 is changed All classes will use the Scoring Penalty of rule 44.3.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Eligible boats may enter by completing on-line entry and paying the required fees at the link accessible through the DIYC regatta website.
- 2.2 The regatta is open to all boats with a valid WFPHRF certificate or a temporary DIYC rating assigned by the DIYC Club Measurer.
- 2.3 Classes include: Spinnaker, Racer Cruiser, Non-Spinnaker, Cruising and Multihull.
- 2.4 Under West Florida PHRF rules, this is a Category 4 event for the distance course and Category 5 for buoy course.
- 2.5 Cruising spinnakers are permitted for the Cruising Class. All Cruising Class boats intending to use a cruising spinnaker must declare so either by email prior to registration to fleetcaptain@diyc.org or by informing the registration desk staff during registration hours.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Early entry fee is \$60 plus state and local taxes. Entry includes three dinners per boat, as well as complimentary vodka cocktail after the race while supplies last.
 - 3.2 Non-US Sailing members, add \$5.00.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration and may be posted online on the event website prior to event (see DIYC Regatta webpage).

The course for the distance race will be posted and announced at the competitors meeting

6 VENUE and FORMAT

- 6.1 The racing area will be that part of Hillsborough Bay lying south of the Davis Island Yacht Club.
- 6.2 Windward/leeward (buoy) course 3 races are scheduled for Spinnaker Classes. One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 6.3 Distance course 1 race is scheduled for Racer/Cruiser, Non-Spinnaker, Cruiser and Multihull.

7 PRIZES

7.1 Awards ceremony and party will follow the event in the Regatta Bar downstairs. All classes will receive awards based on the entries in each class:

- 7.3 This event is part of Suncoast Boat-of-the-Year series and Davis Island Yacht Club Boat-of-the-Year series
- 7.4 There will be an ugly sweater Contest during the awards ceremony. There will be recognition of the ugliest sweaters.
