PHRF Classes San Diego, California Saturday, June 22nd, 2019

Hosted by Southwestern Yacht Club (SWYC)

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. US Sailing Prescriptions to 63.2 and 63.4 will not apply.
- 1.3. RRS rule 55 is changed by adding the following sentence to the rule: "However, discarding biodegradable bands when setting a sail is permitted." Racers remain responsible for compliance with all applicable state and federal laws.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. To be eligible, yachts must have a current Rating Certificate from PHRF San Diego or a current PHRF Southern California Rating Certificate.
- 2.2. This is a PHRF San Diego Annual Championship event. Those who race with their PHRF Southern California Certificate will not be scored for the PHRF San Diego Annual Championship Series.
- 2.3. Yachts possessing both PHRF Southern California and PHRF San Diego certificates shall be scored with their PHRF San Diego rating.

3. ENTRY

- 3.1. All Classes: Timely entries shall be submitted on-line no later than 1700 hours Thursday, June 20th, 2019. Enter on the event website: http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17875
- 3.2. There is a \$35 entry fee per boat.
- 3.3. Late entries may be taken at the discretion of the OA.

4. CLASSES

- 4.1. The regatta is for PHRF Classes.
- 4.2. Classes will be assigned by the Organizing Authority no later than 1800 hours Friday, June 21^{st} , 2019.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 5.1. The first warning signal will be at 1155 hours on Saturday, June 22nd, 2019, with the first start at 1200 hours. Subsequent races will start as soon as practicable.
- 5.2. Three races are scheduled.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1. Sailing Instructions will be available via the event website http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17875 no later than 1800 hours Friday June 21st, 2019.
- 6.2. Notices to competitors will be posted on the RC bulletin board adjacent to the SWYC office and on the event website http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17875 no later than 0900 hours on the day of the event.

7. COURSES

7.1. All courses will be in the Coronado Roads and will be windward-leeward courses.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. All Classes shall be handicapped according to their PHRF "Buoy" ratings, as established in NoR sections 2.1 and 2.3, for all races.
- 8.2. The Low-point Scoring System will be used.
- 8.3. For all classes, each yacht's score shall be the total of all race scores. This modifies RRS Appendix A2.1.
- 8.4. All races started and finished by the Race Committee shall constitute the regatta.

9. AWARDS

9.1. Trophies will be awarded at SWYC as soon as possible after racing. The Arden Trophy will be awarded to the first-place yacht in the class with the greatest time between first and second place.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

10.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
