# Notice of Race

# 1. Rules

The Regatta is organized under the authority of J/24 Fleet 86 and Davis Island Yacht Club. This regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing.

# 2. Eligibility

The regatta is open to all J/24 sailboats as defined by the IJCA.

# **3. Entry and Fees**

Boats may enter prior to the competitor's meeting by completing the online registration and paying the entry fee. Early registration in highly encouraged.

## **5.** Inspection

All boats are subject to random inspection or measurement by the Race Committee at any time during the Regatta for Rules Compliance.

#### 8. Racing Area

Race course will be set in Hillsborough Bay either in the area directly South of DIYC, or on the West side of Davis Islands between Davis Islands and Bayshore Dr.

### 9. Courses

The courses will be Windward/Leeward courses with drop marks per the Sailing Instructions.

#### **10. Scoring**

10.1 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.1

10.2 When five or more races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.1

### **11. Alternative Penalties**

No alternative penalties. 720 rule

#### 12. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for the top three finishers.

#### **13. Logistics Support**
