This Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the One-Design class rules for each class except as any of these are changed by the sailing instructions.

Optimist (advanced and green), 29er, Laser, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Club 420's. Minimum class size is 3 registered boats.

- 2019 OPTIWORLD (2nd of 3 qualifiers)
- 2019 Caribbean Cup Series (1st of 4 qualifiers)

ELIGIBILITY

All competitors must be members of US Sailing, or members of their National Authority, or members of a Yacht Club or Community Sailing Program.

SCORING

The Low Point Scoring system, Appendix A, will apply. One throw out will be allowed for every 6 races sailed. Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

PRIZES

For the Optimist Class, prizes will be awarded top three in Green, Red, White, and Blue fleets, as well as the top finisher Overall.

For 420 and 29er Classes, the top three places will receive prizes.

For the combined Laser Classes, prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers.
