1. RULES

- 1.1 The event shall be governed by:
- 1.1.2 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing(RRS)- Windsurf Competition Rules(WCR).
- 1.1.3 The class rules of the participating classes will apply as amended by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing instructions will take precedence.
- 1.3 No national authority prescriptions will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 2.1 A Minimum of 5 competitors is required to constitute a division. Those entries accepted that do not constitute a division may sail another division as defined by the race committee.
- 2.2 Classes eligible for entry include:
- 2.2.1 Formula, Kona, Longboard, RSX, Techno, Windsurfer LT and Open Wind Foil.

- 3.1.1 Formula Class
- 3.1.2 Kona Class Men, Women, Youth 18 and Under, Masters 65+
- 3.1.3 Longboard Class Men, Women
- 3.1.4 RSX Class Men, Women
- 3.1.5 Techno 293 Class Includes Techno 293 +
- 3.1.6 Green fleet, sailors with less than a year of racing experience and sails 5.8 or smaller
- 3.1.7 Open Windfoil

3.1.8 Windsurfer LT

4. FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee for adult competitors is \$140 USD if received by February 22rd a late fee \$15 USD will be added for entries after February 22rd.
- 4.2 The entry fee for youth(under 21) competitors will be \$125 USD if received by February 23th and a late fee of \$15 USD will be added for entries received after February 22rd.
- 4.3 Late registration will be available onsite March 8 from 1600 to 1900.
- 4.4 Fee includes three lunches, two dinners, and a t-shirt.

- 8.2 Racing will take place on the waters of Clearwater Harbor east of the sailing center and in the Gulf of Mexico East of Sheraton Sand Key.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 One races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 9.2(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race

scores.

(b) When 5 to 11 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10. PRIZES

10.1 Awards will be given to 1-3 for each division with over 10 boards pre-registered by 3-20-19. In divisions with less than ten boards pre-registered by 3-20-19 only first place will be awarded.
