NOTICE OF RACE

Amendment Number 1


1. Delete paragraph 2.2 and substitute the following:

For the SAISA Caribbean Qualifier, each High School will designate one team consisting of 4 sailors. Sailors on the qualifying boats must be ISSA eligible and announced to the race committee prior to the start of the regatta.


Substitutions to the qualifying boats may take place on the water but must be announced to the race committee prior to the start of the race.

Four designated boats, 2 assigned to each school at registration, will be used for the high school portion of the regatta for the entire qualifier. There will be a rotation in these 4 boats after every 2 races. The four designated boats in the qualifier will be scored in placed, meaning their score will be their race score in each race of the MLK Regatta; this means that if a boat in the qualifier finishes 8th out of 12 in the fleet regatta, then their score for the high school qualifier will be an 8.

The Caribbean qualifier will be awarded to the school that has the lowest combined score of the qualifier boats from each school. There will be no "A" or "B" boats in the high school qualifier regatta.
