Sailing Instructions December Moonlight Distance Race Lake Canyon Yacht Club December 22, 2018

- 1. RULES: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017 2020.
- 2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS: Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice window located on the left side of the LCYC clubhouse door.
- 3. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE: Signals made ashore will be displayed from the "Super Dock". If a postponement is signaled ashore, a signal will be made not less than thirty (30) minutes after flag AP is lowered.
- 4. SCHEDULE: Skippers' Meeting at 4:45 PM. First at 5:30 PM.
- 5. STARTING LINE: The starting line will be between the fixed mark outside the breakwater and an orange flag on the end of the main walkway.
- 6. START: The start will be a pursuit race format. Each boat's starting time will be distributed at the Skippers Meeting.
- 7. COURSE: The course will be distributed at the Skippers Meeting.
- 8. FINISH LINE: The finish line will be between the fixed mark outside the breakwater and an orange flag on the end of the main walkway. All boats will take their finish time and report it to the PRO or a scorer designated by the PRO.
- 9. TIME LIMIT: Any boats not finished by 10:00PM will be scored DNF.
- 10. COMMUNICATION: Racers are requested, but not required, to monitor VHF Channel 68 for mutual safety communications.
- 11. RETIREMENT: Racers are strongly requested to report retirements to the PRO or a designated scorer in person, on VHF 68, or by cell phone.
