

Notice of Race 2019 Gulfport Weta Regatta March 2-3, 2019

1. Organizing Authority

The organizing authority is the Gulfport Yacht Club.

2. Rules

- 2.1 This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 2.2 The North American Weta One Design Class Rules are applicable to this event. The class standard and square main sail are legal for this event and used according to Weta Class Rules.

3. Eligibility & Entry

The regatta is open to the Weta Class Sailboat, both Single handed and double handed divisions.

4. Registration & Fees

- 4.2 Registration is \$60 per single handed boat and \$85 per double handed boat.
- 4.3 Regatta Entry Fee includes opening reception and one dinner (two dinners for double handed).
- 4.4 Registrations and payment received before February 2, 2019 will receive a \$10 discount.
- 4.5 Online registration will close February 22, 2019.

7. Sailing Instructions

8. Venue

Racing will be in Boca Ceiga Bay.

9. Scoring

9.1 Two (2) races constitute a regatta.

9.2 When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.

10. Prizes

Awards will be given out according to the number of registrants in each division and overall.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. Lauching, Storage and Charters

All competing boats may be stored at GYC inside the club gates. Boats must launch from GYC beach. If you are interested in chartering a boat, please contact Dick Hitchock at Weta Florida, www.wetaflorida.com, or on Facebook.

13. Parking
