NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS)
- 1.2. RRS Appendix V1 shall apply
- 1.3. The first sentence of RRS 40 is changed so that competitors shall comply with the obligations of RRS 40 (wear a PFD) whether or not the Race Committee displays flag Y with one sound.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to boats of the Ultimate 20 Class, the helmsperson must be an active member of the Class Association
- 2.2. Entry may be made online, using Regatta Manager at this URL: http://www.regattamanager.org/event/18078
- 2.3. Entries must be submitted by 1700 on April 5, 2019

3. FEES

- 3.1. Entry fee is \$120
- 3.2. This fee includes all hoist and berthing fees during the regatta.
- 3.3. One car parking pass per entry will also be provided to each team.

4. BOATS

The regatta will be sailed in Ultimate 20 Class sailboats. Each entry shall comply with the class rules as specified by the Ultimate 20 Class Association.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7. VENUE

Racing shall occur in southern Monterey Bay, near Monterey, CA, USA.

8. COURSES

- 8.1. The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward and further described in the Sailing Instructions
- 8.2. The race course will be shared with the Monterey Shields Fleet, who will be racing in the Ocean Great Lakes Challenge Regatta

9. SCORING

- 9.1. The regatta shall be comprised of a maximum of eight races. A minimum of three race is required to constitute a series
- 9.2. No scores will be excluded until five races have been completed. This changes RRS A2.

10. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top finishers. The number of prizes will depend on the number of entrants. One prize for three boats, two for five boats, and three prizes for a minimum of seven competitors.

11. DISCLAIMER AND LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. BERTHING

Dock space will be provided for at MPYC or on specified nearby docks.

13. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

All boats shall remain in the water from 1000 on Friday, April 26 until the last race has been completed or if special permission has been obtained from the race committee.

14. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Each boat shall carry a VHF radio capable of receiving and transmitting on VHF channel 68.

15. SOCIAL

No fees for social events are included with entry. Competitors are encouraged to attend the dinner to be held at the MPYC clubhouse after racing on Saturday, April 27. More details on this dinner will be published as they are available.

16. LODGING
