

# 2019 Hobie Wave North American Championships

June 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> - Clear Lake, IA



## NOTICE OF RACE

**ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:** Hobie Class Association of North America, in conjunction with HCNA Division 7.

**RULES:** This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), by the one-design class rules for each participating class of boat, and by this Notice of Regatta, except as any of these are modified by the Sailing Instructions. This is an international event, therefore, pursuant to the US Sailing prescription to RRS 88.2, the US Sailing prescription to RRS 40 is deleted.

**ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:** This event is open to all class legal Hobie Waves. All crewpersons must be 2019 HCA-NA members, per IHCA Class Rule 26. Register online at [regattanetwork.com](http://regattanetwork.com)

**FEES:** The entry fee is \$75 if received no later than May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2019. After May 20<sup>th</sup> entry fee will be \$100. Social tickets (including meals and banquet) will be available at the venue.

**MEASUREMENTS:** Boats will not be weighed in at this event. Competitors are responsible for ensuring their equipment is IHCA Class Legal. Crew members will be weighed in accordance with the class rules. During the event, any boat may be subject to inspection by a designated technical official.

There will be 3 days of championship racing (06/10-06/12) with objective of 3 to 5 races per day. Four races are required to constitute a series, and there is no maximum number of races. No Warning signal will be made after 1500 on Wednesday, June 12<sup>th</sup>.

All competitors are welcome to participate in a Wave sailing clinic run by Jane Sherrod prior to the event on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>.

**AWARDS:** The top placing sailor shall be named the 2019 Hobie Wave North American Champion.

**INSURANCE:** Each participating boat shall have current third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000 USD. Proof of this insurance must be presented at registration.
