1. RULES

1.2.6 The US Sailing Championship Support Vessel Policy. This will be a Grade 1 Coaching event

16. SCORING

16.2. Boats scored TLE shall be scored points equal to one more than the finish place of the last boat to finish within the finish window established in SI 14.2. This changes rules 35, 63.1, A4 and A5.

18. COACHING AND OUTSIDE CONTACT

- 18.1. This is a Grade 1 Event as defined in the US Sailing Championship Support Vessel Policy. See https://www.ussailing.org/competition/resources/coaching-and-support-boat-policy/
- 18.2. All coaches and/or support personnel shall register by the deadline stated in the notice of race. Coaches shall provide proof of current First Aid, CPR and US Sailing Smallboat Level 1 instructor certification or its equivalent from another NGB. Foreign coaches will need to provide proof of \$1 million (US) insurance in the United States.
- 18.3. Registered coach boats shall be marked with a numbered or colored identification flag provided by the organizing authority at registration. Registered coaches may have an additional person on their boat solely for safety and regatta management purposes.

SAILFEST JUNIOR SAILING CHAMPIONSHIPS RED, WHITE AND BLUE FLEET

- 8.4 The finish mark will be a ball.
- 9.4 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing.
