## ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Girts Rekevics Memorial Foul Weather Race and Cruise event starts AYC's 2019 Racing season. This is a fun-filled unique event because it is both a distance sailing race and the first cruise event of the year! Getting there is only half the fun! We encourage all AYC members to join the racers for a social hour Saturday night beginning at 5:30 PM followed by the dinner 6:30 PM at the San Juan Island Yacht Club located on the waterfront in beautiful Friday Harbor.

The event consists of a race and a cruise from Anacortes to Friday Harbor. For Racers; the Foul Weather Race is open to all yachts that have completed the registration process using the Anacortes Yacht Club on-line registration system available on the club website, and have a valid current PHRF rating. If your boat is not listed in the PHRF-NW online database, bring your rating certificate to the Skippers' Meeting Friday evening to be scored.

As in the past, racers will be starting at 09:30 AM between R2 and the Refinery Dock in Fidalgo Bay, Anacortes, and finish between the NW corner of Brown Island and the NOAA Weather Station in Friday Harbor, San Juan Island. A total distance of 19.5nm. Please refer to the event Sailing Instruction (SI's) for details.

For Cruisers; there will be a friendly "Predicted Log" competition, that will challenge your dead reckoning and navigational skills. A trophy will be awarded to those with the most accurate predicted logs. Rules on this years predicted log challenge will be coming out shortly.

EVENT FEES: The entry fee is \$45.00 per racing boat. \$20.00 for cruising boats. These fees cover the event & trophy costs and the rental of the San Juan Yacht Club's facility. Race Registration must be completed on-line by 6pm Friday, February 22, 2019.

EVENT CLOTHING: This year we have decided to offer event "swag" that you can wear with your foulies on! Commemorative Bomber hats (aka "Flap Hats") like the one Girts wears on our logo are available, in Red and Black. Each hat will sport an official hat pin with the 2019 Girts Rekevics Memorial Foul Weather

Skippers and crew and cruisers registered by February 22nd will be eligible. Please advise crew to purchase dinner tickets online in order to receive their drawing tickets.

MOORAGE IN FRIDAY HARBOR: Moorage is available at the Port of Friday Harbor. Advanced reservations are typically not required at this time of year, but you can call them in advance at (360) 378-2688. For those participants staying overnight in Friday Harbor, on their boats, we will be able to use the San Juan Yacht Club's shower facilities at no charge along with reciprocal moorage at the end of F Dock. "First Come First Served". Rafting is allowed, up to three boats.
