Rules

The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing. A free PDF of the rules is available at http://www.sailing.org/documents/racingrules/ or by Googling "Racing Rules of Sailing pdf" and selecting the World Sailing website. All PHRF boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of receiving transmissions on channels 11 and 72.

Eligibility and Entry

Open to all mono-hull and multi-hull boats that hold a current West Florida PHRF handicap rating. Open to Flying Scots, E-Scows and other one-design classes.

If boats do not have a current West Florida PHRF handicap rating, the Race Committee will assign a rating. These boats will not be eligible for prizes.

Entries may be submitted online at http://regattanetwork.com/event/18256, or on the attached form mailed to Bird Key Yacht Club 301 Bird Key Drive, Sarasota FL 34236. Registration by mail requires payment by check payable to Bird Key Yacht Club. For boats in PHRF classes include a copy of the most recent WFPHRF certificate. Additional information is available at https://sites.google.com/view/bkycsailing. The regatta is a Sarasota Bay Yachting Association Boat of the Year event.

Format

One-Design classes will sail up to three races on a Drop Mark Course using inflatable marks. Spinnaker, Non-spinnaker, Pocket Cruiser, Cruising and Multi-hull PHRF classes will sail one race on the Random-leg Course in "Pursuit" format using fixed government and possibly inflatable marks.

Fees

The entry fee for all boats is \$60, which includes two tickets for the Saturday dinner. Additional dinner tickets are available for \$20 each. Tickets for various alcoholic beverages (wine, beer and mixed drinks) will be available between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm on Friday, April 26. Purchases of additional dinners, beverages and merchandise can be made with cash, checks or credit/debit cards, with a 3% processing fee. No processing fee is charged on Regatta Networks transactions.

Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions and scratch sheets for each class will be available at the registration desk and from the Race Committee.

Scoring

A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. One race is required to constitute a series.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the top boats in each class, depending on entries. The Sarasota Bay Cup Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the best performing boat as determined by the Race Committee.
