Rendezvous: At 1000 in vicinity of Annapolis Area Mark "X".

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 77 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and an inflatable orange mark.

Signals: RRS 26 (Starting Races)

The first Warning Signal is scheduled for 1100 Starts are planned for the following classes:

PHRF A0 PHRF A1 PHRF A2 J/105 PHRF B/C

Course: Drop mark type courses or as designated by letters displayed on Race Committee boat.

For drop mark courses, rounding marks will be yellow.

Change Marks: when changing a leg of the course in accordance with GSI rule 9, new next mark will alternate between yellow marks with a dark colored band and Yellow marks

without a band so the new mark is different from the mark being changed.

If used, Offset mark will be a smaller yellow mark; Gate marks, if used, will be yellow.

Finish: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and an inflatable orange mark.

Time Limit: The Time Limit for each race is 2 hours 30 minutes. Boats finishing after that time will be

scored TLE equal to the number of boats finishing within the Time Limit plus 2 points, not worse than the number of boats starting in their class. This alters RRS 35, A4.1, A4.2

and A5. No initial Warning Signal will be made after 14:30 hours.

Scoring: Scoring will use PHRF Time-On-Time(ToT) with Time Correction Factor(TCFs) calculated

using: TCF=650/(550+PHRFrating).

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing

(RRS) 2017-2020. The CBYRA Green Book General Sailing will apply. The "US SER Nearshore Category" of the US Sailing Safety Equipment

Requirements (available on the US Sailing website, www.USSailing.org) will apply.

Protests: Due on race day at the CBYRA Office within 2 hours of the protesting boat's finish.

but not later than 1900. Protests will be heard at CBYRA Office starting at 2000 on

Thursday 25 April 2019.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5 & 3rd/7+ starters. Awards will be mailed. Preliminary and final results will be

posted on the event website and by CBYRA.

Other: Special Instructions: It is the Race Committees intention to run up to 3 drop mark races. The

Race Committee will indicate its intention to run additional races by flying code flag "R" at the finish. Subsequent races (if any) will be started for each class individually. About 1 minute before the warning signal for each subsequent race, the course for the class to start will be

designated and multiple horns sounded. This is not a timed signal.
