# **Hillsboro Inlet to Palm Beach Regatta**

#### The Rules

- 1. The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Sailing Instructions will govern the Racing.
- 2. Any seaworthy sailing vessel that has an auxiliary engine is eligible. It is the responsibility of the Master of the vessel to determine its seaworthiness.
- 3. Each vessel shall have a crew of not less than 2 persons and carry a VHF radio.
- 4. Each boat is required to have a representative at the Competitors meeting to pick up the sailing instructions and to monitor channel 68 before and during the race for any changes or modifications.

### **Entry & Fees**

- Entry Fees shall be paid to the Palm Beach Sailing Club no later than June 5, 2019.

- 2. Entry Fees: Early Registration by May 17 \$40; Regular Registration by May 31st \$60; Late Registration June 1 June 4 \$80. Fees based on date paid.
- 3. This Fee will include one dinner ticket.
- 4. Additional dinners can be purchased for \$30. Contact PBSC via <a href="mailto:office@pbsail.org">office@pbsail.org</a> or 561-881-0809 to purchase additional dinners. On June 5 the dinner fee increases to \$40 per person -- subject to availability.
- 5. Cancellations made before June 1 will be refundable and must be done by contacting <u>fleetcaptain@pbsail.org</u> via email, or phone 561-351-5784.

## **Classes & Rating**

- 1. There will be 5 classes: Assigned Rating Class (ARC), Corinthian, JAM, and Multihull (MUL), and Gunkhole (GNK).
- 2. The Race committee will assign ratings to unrated vessels. Their decision on ratings will be final.
- 3. The ARC class will be the performance racing class.
- 4. The Corinthian class will be for cruisers who wish to carry downwind specialty sails including spinnakers.
- 5. The JAM classes will be a jib and main only classes.
- 6. The MUL class is for cruising catamarans only.
- 7. The Gunkhole Class (GNK) all levels of cruisers who want to race good for first time racers Jib and Main only.

8. Results will be calculated using the HISC proprietary scoring system – the handicap distance of the race will be 25 miles.

For the 2019 Hillsboro to Palm Beach race, all entries which have a valid 2018 or 2019 PHRFSEF handicap rating and race according to that rating are eligible for this award based on best overall corrected time finish.
