1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020
- 1.2. International Sunfish Class Association (ISCA) rules, and as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Each competitor shall be a 2019 member of his/her respective country's Class Association affiliated to ISCA.
- 2.2. Competitors may join the class utilizing the following link: https://sunfish.wildapricot.org/join-us
- 2.3. Registration may be completed online at http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/18336
- 2.4. Checks are also accepted and should be made payable to "Lake Norman Yacht Club" and mailed to John Butine, 9700 Stewart Spring Ln, Charlotte, NC 28216, along with Entry Form on Addendum 1.

3. ENTRY FEES

- 3.1 Entry Fee: \$60 (After April 1, 2019: \$70)
- 3.2 Registration fee includes: Regatta T-shirt, dinner on Saturday, awards ceremony lunch, breakfast and lunch on racing days.
 - PLEASE NOTE: You must register online, or mail-in received by the April 1 early deadline to be guaranteed a Regatta T-shirt.
- 3.3 Registration fees shall be free of any transfer and/or banking costs and/or commissions. Any charge shall be reimbursed by competitors to complete their entries.
- 3.4 Meal plans available for family members and guests. Saturday dinner is \$15 ea., Saturday lunch for \$7 ea.

5. MEASUREMENT

Boats and equipment must be compliant with current ISCA rules. Sails, rigging, boats and equipment may be inspected or measured prior to racing, and may be spot-checked any time during the regatta.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in for the regatta.

7. VENUE

The regatta venue will be Lake Norman Yacht Club, Mooresville, NC. Racing will be in the waters of Lake Norman.

8. THE COURSES

The courses will be windward – leeward, triangles, or combinations thereof.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A4, shall apply.
- 9.2 One (1) race is required to constitute a series.
- 9.3 A maximum of six (6) races will be sailed.
- 9.4 When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. (This modifies RRS Appendix A2.1)

10. PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

- a) Top five finishers
- b) Highest placed Junior competitor
- c) This regatta is a qualifier for the 2020 World Championship regatta.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. LODGING

There are several chain hotel options at exits 33 and 36 off I-77. These are approximately 8-9 miles from the club

Camping is welcome on the grounds of LNYC and campers are invited to use the showers and restroom facilities. Additional information about LNYC can be found at www.lakenormanyachtclub.com. If coming by RV, there are no hookups and parking is at the main clubhouse lot. Club rules do not allow pets on the club grounds during club events or regatta weekends.

13. DIRECTIONS

GPS: 297 Yacht Road, Mooresville, NC

From I-77 in either direction, take exit 35, Brawley School Road. Go West on Brawley School Road approximately 7.7 miles to Yacht Road. (at the roundabout/traffic circle, about 7 miles from the exit, go "straight", and Yacht Road is the second street on the left.) Turn left on Yacht Road and go approximately 0.9 miles to the LNYC entrance on the left.
