1. RULES: The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the current edition of The Racing Rules of Sailing. Any changes to the RRS will be addressed in the Sailing Instructions (Alternate Penalties, etc.)

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

2.1 The regatta is open to all one-design classes. Expected Classes: Thistle, Flying Scot, and Open. All other classes with 5 or more registered boats will have separate starts.

2.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering during the registration period.

Entry Fees: US Sailing members \$60, Non-members \$65.

5. RACE AREA: All races will be on Lake Logan Martin near Birmingham Sailing Club.

6. SCORING:

- 7.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A (The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020) will apply, except
 - that a boat's final score shall be the sum of all races, with no throw-outs. This changes rule A2.
- 7.2 Boats not sailing in a one-design fleet will be scored using the US Sailing Portsmouth Yardstick.
- 7.3 Five (5) races are scheduled. One race will constitute a regatta.

7. Awards: Awards will be per class as follows: 1st - 3nd for 5 or more boats.
