NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules, as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing, 2017-2020 (RRS)*; Thistle Class Rules, as documented in the Thistle Class Constitution; TCA Bylaws; TCA Chief Measurement Rulings and Specifications; and Thistle Atlantic Coast Championship 2019 Sailing Instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to boats and competitors meeting the eligibility requirements as described in the (TCA) rules. **All Skippers must be TCA members. All boats must be Registered and TCA Dues Paid.**
- 2.2 Eligible participants are encouraged to register in advance for the regatta by completing the registration form. Registration form can be found on the TAYC website under the *Racing* tab at www.tayc.com

3 FEES

- 3.1 Entries received by June 1, 2019 \$145.00
Entries received after June 1, 2019 \$160.00
- 3.2 The entry fee includes continental breakfast on Saturday and Sunday, 3 dinners on Saturday and after-race hors d'oeuvres on Sunday. Additional dinner tickets \$32. Box lunch \$9

4 VENUE

Races will be sailed on the Choptank River southwest of Choptank River Light, weather dependent. Hoist launching from Tred Avon Yacht Club (TAYC).

- 7.1 The courses to be sailed will be either windward-leeward or triangle-windward-leeward
7.2 Offset marks and leeward gates may be used.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

9 SCORING

- 9.1 A boat’s regatta score will be the total of all her race scores.
9.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 10.1 Pursuant to Chief Measurer’s Rulings 65 and 74, competitors may receive VHF radio transmissions from the Race Committee concerning safety, notice of on-course-side (OCS) boats and general information to assist in the management of the event.
10.2 The RC will monitor VHF channel 71 for courtesy broadcasts and emergency/safety related situations.

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be given to the top five teams.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4 Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13 OTHER

Please observe the 25 MPH speed limit in Oxford. It is strictly enforced.
