Description of Incident

Description

371 and 1509 were both over early and reaching back towards the starting line. 371 was about a half boat length ahead and a half boat length to weather. As the boats approached the line from the course side, 1509 hailed "come up" while concurrently turning hard into 371. 371 turned away immediately but there was NO opportunity to avoid contact. 371 hailed "protest" and put up the flag immediately. The contact was hard, and while there does not appear to be any visible damage, fiberglass crunching was heard. Once 1509 passed astern, 371 did a 360 penalty turn consisting of a gybe and a tack and continued racing. diagram to follow...
