1. RULES

1.1. This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the “*The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017 – 2020*”

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Eligible boats and drivers may enter by completing an online entry form available through the Regatta Network website at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/18580> More information is available on the ASMBYC website <http://www.asmbyc.org/> Plus, additional help will also be given out at the Beginning Race Start Seminar held at PMYC <http://pmyc.org/> on Tuesday, April 30 at 1900 hours (7 PM).
- 2.2. There will be at least two classes, cruising and performance class. Classes may be added depending on participants, 2 or more boats may constitute a new class. Race committee may combine or segregate classes at their discretion.
- 2.3. Skipper experience shall be limited to 1 PHRF, 1 One Design or 2 Cruising class races.
- 2.4. Yacht club membership is not required for skippers.
- 2.5. The entry fee is FREE for all boats. Completed entry forms will be accepted by 10:00 HRS on Sunday, May 5, 2019.



3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1. The schedule time for the warning signal for the first race is 11:55 AM
- 3.2. The R/C will attempt to run up to three (3) races such as to finish by 1600 hours.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS / SKIPPERS MEETING

- 4.1. The Sailing Instructions and classes will be posted on <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/18580> by 1900 hours May 4, 2019.
- 4.2. Sailing instructions will also be available at the Skipper Meeting at PMYC on Sunday, May 5, at 0900 hours.

5. COURSES / SCORING

- 5.1. Courses will be windward / leeward using ASMBYC Marina Del Rey Course Chart 17. For missing marks the use of inflatable orange and yellow marks may be used.
- 5.2. No race score will be excluded. This changes RRS A2
- 5.3. The starting area will be in the vicinity of SS Mark.

6. HOSPITALITY

- 6.1. Post-race hospitality and trophy presentation will be held at Pacific Mariners' Yacht Club: 13915 Panay Way, Marina del Rey, CA

7. TROPHIES

- 7.1. Trophies will be presented by ASMBYC to the winners of their respective divisions.
- 7.2. The Darien Murray Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the fleet with the most qualifying skippers.
