- The Grapevine Sailing Club (GSC) cordially invites you to attend the Mayor's Cup Regatta, May 4th - 5th 2019.

#### Site:

- GSC is a private sailing club, located on the south shore of Lake Grapevine at Scott's Landing Marina. Directions and other information relating to GSC appear at [www.grapevinesailing.org](http://www.grapevinesailing.org)

#### Rules:

- The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020, applicable one-design class rules, and the Mayor's Cup Sailing Instructions (SIs).

#### Racing:

- One (1) race shall constitute a regatta.

#### Eligibility

- Open to all sailors: GSC members and non-members alike.

#### Fleets & Handicaps:

- Four (4) or more one-design boats may constitute a fleet.
- Non one-design boats will be grouped in PHRF fleets.

#### Courses:

- Races will be sailed on courses of windward/leeward design or variations thereof from GSC course illustrations.

#### Entries & Fees:

- The entry fee for this regatta is \$75.00.
- Early online registrants that enter before 2400 (midnight) CDT Friday, May 3rd, 2019, will receive a \$10.00 discount.
- Members of US Sailing will receive a \$5.00 discount at any time. Only one US Sailing Member discount allowed per entry.

**The entry fee includes:**

- Participation in the regatta
- Participation in the regatta's awards program
- Complimentary breakfast for skipper & crew on both Saturday and Sunday

- Complimentary beer and beverages at social following racing
- Use of a ramp for launching and haul out
- Use of mast hoists for mast stepping
- Trailer storage/boat dockage for the duration of the regatta

  - 1630–2000 - Late Registration at the Clubhouse plus launch assistance and boat slip assignments
  - 1630–2000 - Happy Hour, refreshments provided
- **Saturday, May 4th, 2019**
  - 0730 - Complimentary Breakfast
  - 0800 - Registration Closes
  - 0930 - Skipper's Meeting
  - 1100 - First warning signal for race 1. (Additional races to follow)
  - Lunch on the water; (*lunch is not provided, be sure to bring your own*)
  - 1730 - Refreshments, Silent and Live Auction
  - 1800 - Dinner, plus Blowout Party, and your favorite refreshments (*dinner tickets by registration online, party is free*)
  - 2000 - Silent Auction Closes
- **Sunday, May 5th, 2019**
  - 1000 - First warning signal Additional races may follow. There are five races scheduled for the regatta
  - 1300 - No start warning signal will be made after 1300 on Sunday
