Rendezvous: At 1100 at Region 1 Mark B (RG "A") at Turkey Point.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and Region 1 Mark "B" (RG"A"). If code flag "L" is

displayed, the starting line may be moved to between orange flag on Race Committee boat and another navigation aid or a temporary drop mark. Temporary mark automatically becomes mark "Y" and may be

used as a course mark.

Signals: RRS 26 (Starting Races).

**Course:** Designated by letters and numbers displayed on the Race Committee boat. Special race buoy drop-marks

or government marks based on Region 1 Standard Racing Marks.

Finish: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and last posted mark, unless course is shortened after the

start at a designated mark of the course.

**Time Limit:** A 4 hour maximum time limit from the starting time for each class shall be imposed for all boats in a class.

At the discretion of the Race Committee this time limit may be adjusted, depending on time constraints

resulting from any postponements. This changes RRS 35.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in <u>The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2017 (RRS)</u>.

RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, "If there is a conflict between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice Of Race, the Event Sailing Instructions shall apply." All changes to this NOR

will be posted on the NERYC website prior to Saturday 8 June 2019.

**Protests:** Written protests must be submitted to the Race Committee within 1 hour of your returning to the NERYC dock.

Verbal notice of protest delivered to RC boat at finish.

Awards: 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class awarded at the Post Race Party at NERYC on the day of the event. Some

fleets may be split or combined for awards based on participation.
