## Notice of Race

### Rules

The regatta will be governed by the *Rules* as defined in the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, the SOS-TEX Bylaws, the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race. The SOS-TX Bylaws are available at:

***Autopilot and/or wind-powered self-steering gear are allowed. This modifies RRS 52.  
Crew size is limited to single or double hand classes.***

### Eligibility

This regatta is open to all boats with valid 2019 PHRF-GB certificates and GBCA Cruising Club Handicap ratings subject to the discretion of the race committee. Single and double-handed divisions will be formed in accordance with SOS-TEX bylaws. At least one crew member must be 18 years of age or older. A minimum of three boats is required to form a class. Classes which have formed by 1700 hours Saturday, April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2019 will be awarded trophies as follows:

- 3 boats: 1<sup>st</sup> place
- 4-5 boats: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> place
- 6-8 boats: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place
- 9-10 boats: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> place
- 11 or more boats: 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> place

Classes which form after 1700 hours Saturday, April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2019 are eligible for trophies, but trophies may not be available for presentation at the awards ceremony.

PHRF certificates should be verified as available for viewing on the PHRFGB.com website, emailed to race management or delivered at the competitors briefing. The entry fee will be \$40.00. Current Senior members of GBCA will receive a \$5.00 discount. Entry fees will be refunded if the entry is withdrawn prior to the entry deadline. The deadline for all entries is Friday, April 19, 2019 at 16:30 CDT; however, entries received after 2359 CST, Saturday, April 13, 2019 will be subject to a \$10.00 late fee.

## **Courses**

The racing area will be located in that part of Galveston Bay bounded by The Bayport Ship Channel, The Houston Ship Channel and the shoreline between Red Bluff and Eagle Point in San Leon. It is the intention of the Race Committee to set a course which requires racers to make three separate laps around fixed and /or RC dropped marks which may be made in any order. The course is planned to be approximately 22-24nm. This will be a reverse start (pursuit) race, with the start time for each boat based on its PHRF rating
